FROM THE PASTOR:

Out of his fullness, we have all received grace upon grace already given.

(John 1:16)

Easter is "late" this year, and the celebration of Christ's Resurrection will occur on Sunday, April 20th. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th and Emanuel will once again be celebrating the beginning of Lent with an Ash Wednesday Service that evening.

More than just a tradition of the church, Lent is a time of reflection on Christ and his ministry, which culminated in his Passion, all leading up to the glory and significance of the Resurrection on Easter. At Emanuel, our tradition of a Lenten Soup & Study will continue beginning on Wednesday March 12th and ending on Wednesday April 16th and is entitled: "The Way of Grace."

In John's gospel he describes the Incarnation of Jesus Christ as God pouring out the grace of salvation on top of the grace God has been pouring out on humanity since creation. Paul reminds us that we are saved by grace, unearned and undeserved favor from God, that does not come from us, but from God alone. The grace of salvation is Jesus Christ provided through his life and ministry, which of course is the gospel message.

In our study we will hear and engage in discussion on the varying perspectives of certain gospel stories of grace, as Jesus journeys to the cross and ultimately his resurrection. Our goal being to encounter sacred time of reflection, renewal, and spiritual deepening of our faith and our life together in Christ.

Praise Band Coordinator Kristin Kaster

Each month over the next several, we will be highlighting one of Emanuel's staff positions so the church can better understand its purpose.



For many years now, Emanuel has been blessed with wonderful musicians and joyful voices all dedicated to praising the Lord through music by the Emanuel Praise Band. The Praise Band leads the worship at our 10:30a Sunday worship service leading the congregation in contemporary Christian music.

The Praise Band Coordinator guides the band by first coordinating with the pastor on the scripture, theme, and message of the worship service. Music appropriate to the service is chosen to enhance the message and the worship experience of the congregation.

Discernment in music selection is a key skill for the Praise Band Coordinator. Familiarity, capabilities, difficulty, planning rehearsals, availability of musicians and vocalists all contribute to providing the best experience for praising God. These variables must all come together, each week, in order for Emanuel to engage in praise worship together.

Each Sunday we are blessed to experience Kristin's beautiful singing voice. But her talent goes much deeper. As Praise Band Coordinator, Kristin ensures and manages many of the technical aspects of what you hear and enjoy. Beyond just volume control, which actually occurs at the sound board, Kristin manages microphone selection and placement, floor monitor placement and settings, coordinates the mix of the musicians and vocalists in terms of those who are present on Sunday morning and their sound and voices. She supports the Proclaim slide show (projected on the screen) by inserting the words of each song so that, for the congregation, the song is easy to follow and to sing.

The Praise Band Coordinator is currently considered a "part-time" position here at Emanuel. We are blessed to have Kristin in this crucial staff position.
