YOUTH SCHOLARSHIPS

One of God's major blessings at Emanuel is the amazing number of young people— children, middle and high school, and college, that are involved here at our church. One of the ways we support them, and they support the church is through post high school scholarships.

Emanuel is pleased to announce the creation of a new scholarship program available to high school and college youth who are active in the church and willing to serve on our audio/video tech worship. The Tech Services Scholarship provides funds for college, trade school, or seminary following high school. It is open to all high school, college, and trade school/seminary students. Non-senior(12th grade) high school students are eligible, and scholarship funds will build up for use after graduation. The Administrative Board has funded the scholarship for two positions which are currently filled through December. This is a wonderful opportunity to support our youth here at Emanuel so PLEASE CONSIDER DONATING to the Tech Services Scholarship Fund.

Emanuel also offers another post high school scholarship fund for our youth through **The Lange Memorial Scholarship** Fund. The Lange Memorial Fund provides annual scholarships to graduating high school seniors and current college/trade school students. Applications will be available beginning in January through our church web site.
